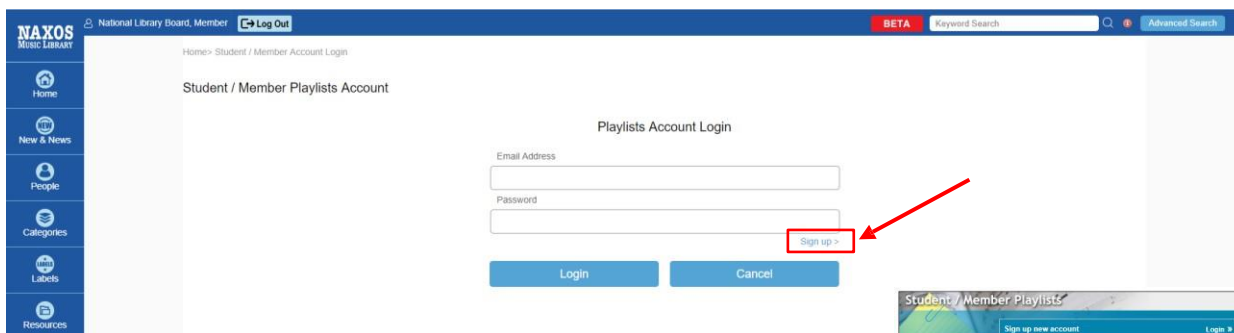
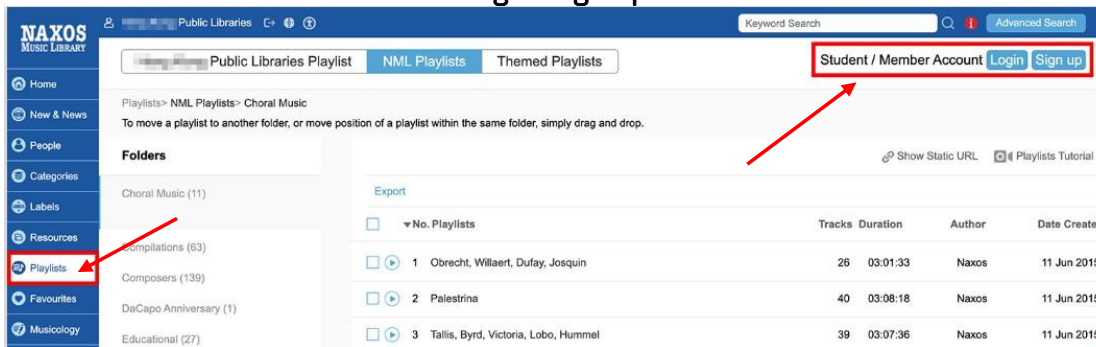


Accessing *Naxos Music Library* and *Naxos Music Library Jazz* with Mobile Devices : <https://assets.naxosmusiclibrary.com/sharedfiles/NML/en/MobileAccess/>

1. Download the app NML from your respective store – App Store for iOS and Google Play for Android devices.
2. If you have your own Student/Member Account, your email address and password will act as your login credentials for the NML / NML Jazz mobile app. Simply log in.
3. If you do not have your own Student/Member Account yet, sign up on the institution **Playlist Page**: <https://blausanne.naxosmusiclibrary.com/folder>  
[limited access to the HEMU-CL “Grotte-2” computer network or via VPN]
4. Follow the below steps to create your Member Playlist account.
  - Login to your institution/library’s NML / NML Jazz / NML World
  - Click **“Playlist”** on the left blue column
  - Click **“Student/Member Account Login/Sign Up”**



- Click “sign up” and Fill in the form to create your own personal

5. After completing the **Sign Up** Form, you will receive an email. Complete the registration process by clicking the activation link in that email.
6. The email address and password you register with will act as your login credentials for the NML / NML Jazz mobile app. Now you can create and save personal playlists, and enjoy the service everywhere through the mobile app. Please note that under certain rare circumstances, it can take up to 15 minutes for your Student/Member Account registration to be completed. Once your own account has been created successfully, you can also log in to the web version of the service directly on the general Login Page.
7. We need to validate that you are still an authorised user of your institution biannually. Your access with mobile app will be temporarily deactivated if you haven't logged into the web version of the service via your institution's authentication system for six months. **Please LOGIN on the Playlist Page** (at the top right corner) to reactivate your student account.
